Office Desktop

- Installed on a local computer

Smart Office Desktop - Limitations

- **Single Location Only**: Best suited for SMEs with one office; not ideal for multi-branch setups.
- Manual Data Sync: Requires USB or LAN-based sync if Wi-Fi is unstable.
- Limited Multi-User Access: Not designed for concurrent access by multiple admins or HR staff.
- No Remote Access: Cannot be accessed outside the local network.
- No Auto Backup to Cloud: Backup must be configured manually to a local or network drive.
- No ESS Portal: Employee Self-Service (ESS) features are limited or unavailable.

Smart Office Web - Limitations

- Requires Local Server Setup: Needs a dedicated server and network configuration.
- **Dependent on Network Stability**: Performance can degrade with poor LAN or internet connectivity.
- No Simultaneous Desktop Use: Cannot share the same SQL database with the Desktop version.
- Limited Offline Functionality: Cannot function without internet or intranet access.
- Static IP May Be Needed: For remote access to devices across locations, unless using cloud DNS.

Smart Office 365 Cloud - Limitations

- Internet Dependency: Fully cloud-based, so no access during internet outages.
- Limited Customization: Less flexibility for deep backend customization compared to Desktop/Web.
- **Subscription-Based**: Ongoing monthly cost per employee; may not suit all budgets.
- **Data Hosting**: Data is stored on third-party cloud servers—may raise compliance concerns for some industries.
- Advanced Features May Cost Extra: Modules like payroll, PMS, or asset tracking may require additional fees.
