Fingerprint attendance device DS-K1T804AEF

Frequently Asked Questions

1. How do I reset the password?

- You'll need to follow the steps outlined in the <u>user manual</u>, or contact Hikvision support if the device is locked.

2. What if the device is exposed to rain or moisture?

- Avoid placing it in damp or dusty environments. It's designed for indoor use, so exposure to moisture can cause malfunction.

3. Why is my device not working in extreme temperatures?

- Ensure it's installed within the recommended temperature range and away from direct sunlight or heat sources.

4. How do I clean and maintain the device?

- Use a soft, dry cloth. Avoid alkaline detergents. Keep it away from direct sunlight and electromagnetic interference.

5. Can I connect it to a door sensor?

- Yes! The DS-K1T804AEF supports door sensor integration. You can follow the <u>official guide</u> for wiring and configuration.

6. Is the manual available in English?

- Absolutely. You can view or download the full <u>192-page English manual</u> for detailed setup and troubleshooting.

Q: Can you explain the installation process for this device?

1. Mounting the Device

- **Install a 120 gang box** into the wall where the device will be placed.
- **Route the cables** through the cable hole in the mounting plate.
- **Secure the mounting plate** to the gang box using the supplied screws.
- Align and attach the terminal to the mounting plate from bottom up, fastening it with the built-in buckles.

2. Wiring and Power

- Connect power supply (12V DC) and ground.
- Wire the **door lock**, **exit button**, **door sensor**, and **alarm input/output** as needed.
- Ensure all external devices share the same ground (GND) to avoid electrical issues.

3. Activation and Configuration

- Use iVMS-4200 software or SADP tool to activate the device.
- Set a strong admin password during activation.
- Configure network settings (IP address, gateway, etc.) and enable communication protocols.

4. Registering Users

- Add users locally or via software.
- Register fingerprints, assign cards, and set access permissions.
- You can also sync user data with Hik-Connect or third-party systems.

5. Advanced Configuration

- Set up IN-OUT readers for dual-side access.
- Configure buzzer, access schedules, and linkage actions.

Q: Can you explain the troubleshooting process?

1. Device Offline or Network Issues

- Check IP settings: Ensure the device has a valid IP address, subnet mask, and gateway.
- Verify connectivity: Ping the device from your PC or use SADP/iVMS-4200 to detect it.
- **DNS settings**: Missing DNS entries can cause Hik-Connect to show offline status.

2. Password or Login Problems

- **Forgot password?** You can reset it using the reset button (if available), SADP tool, or by contacting Hikvision support.

3. Buzzer or Door Timeout Issues

- If the buzzer keeps sounding or the door open timeout is misconfigured:
 - Use iVMS-4200 to adjust the door open timeout and buzzer settings.
- Check Hik Vision: DS-K1T804AEF is enable door open timeout buzzer for configuration steps.

4. IN-OUT Reader Malfunction

- Ensure proper wiring and reader configuration.
- Use iVMS-4200 to assign reader roles and test access control logic.

5. General Maintenance Tips

- Keep the device clean and dry.
- Avoid direct sunlight, moisture, and electromagnetic interference.
- Restart the device if the display or fingerprint sensor malfunctions.
